WE ARE PROUD TO ANNOUNCE OUR TRYOUTS ARE SCHEDULED AND NEW TEAMS HAVE BEEN ADDED FOR YOUNGER PLAYERS

UFBA is excited to announce that we are offering 4th grade-Varsity girls and boys teams, and a coed team for 2nd and 3rd graders.

Basketball players in 2nd-12th grade are encouraged to tryout, for free, on Sunday, January 26th and Sunday, February 2nd. **Register here**.

This is going to be a season like no other! With coaching and mentoring on and off the court by highly qualified coaches and leaders, a

weekly open gym, better equipment, and more opportunities for training than before, this is a great time to be a UFBA Baller!

Players in our 2nd and 3rd grade coed league will have eight weeks of training, while players on the 4th grade-Varsity boys and girls teams will play in a ten week season. Our schedule includes:

Practice Tuesday and Thursday
Training & Mentoring Wednesday
Open Gym Friday
Tournaments Throughout the season

UFBA coaches, along with trainers from organizations like the Rochester Royal Ballers, will hold tryouts. **Please note that players are required to attend**

at least one tryout session and should bring their own basketball and water. Team placement will be communicated within 48 hours of the last tryout. We offer generous financial support to players in need; our main focus is to make sure that those players who CAN play at the Elite Club level, DO play at the Elite Club level.
